



## Travel Scholarship

The International Society for Cutaneous Lymphomas will offer (5) travel scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 USD each for investigators from under-represented nations (including Africa, Asia and Eastern Europe) who wish to attend the **4<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Cutaneous Lymphomas, February 12-14, 2020, Barcelona, Spain**. Investigators from these geographic regions are encouraged to apply for this scholarship to present their work. Projects that further the aims of the ISCL will be given priority consideration.

The International Society for Cutaneous Lymphomas (ISCL) is a non-profit worldwide association with the aims of:

- Increasing knowledge of lymphoproliferative and related disorders of the skin.
- Fostering collaboration among clinicians, scientists and regional or national groups by being sponsor of an international registry of cutaneous lymphomas.
- Promoting dissemination of scientific information by organizing meetings.
- Favoring consensus about diagnosis, management and treatment of cutaneous lymphoma.

### Who Should Apply:

- Investigators who practice or conduct research in under-represented nations, (specifically Africa, Asia or Eastern Europe) with a GDP per capita of less than \$30,000 USD.
- Those who have submitted an abstract to the 4<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Cutaneous Lymphomas. (Scholarships will be awarded to submitters who have been accepted for Oral or Poster Presentation.)

### Award Details:

- Complimentary base registration to the 4<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Cutaneous Lymphomas to take place February 12-14, 2020, in Barcelona, Spain.
- \$2,000 USD check awarded at the congress, to help cover travel costs.
- Certificate suitable for framing.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by December 1, 2019.
